- Lift passes are not transferable.
 - Under our terms and conditions governing prices, families mean the parents plus children²⁾ and youths¹⁾ living with both parents in a joint household.
 - The misuse of lift passes will result in the immediate revocation of the lift ticket and the exclusion from transportation. Furthermore, a fine of at least € 50.00 and the full fee for a day ticket will be charged. Even an attempt to transfer a lift pass to another person is considered a misuse.
 - Key card required. The deposit of € 3.00 is refunded when you return the card undamaged. Cards for day tickets: different regulations in the individual regions.
 - Photo generally required for 8 days and more. Photo machines at all main ticket offices.
 - Multi-day passes can also be purchased and used after 3pm the previous day. Exception: Tauernseilbahn cable cars in Haus/Ennstal.
 - Ticket holders shall keep their lift passes where third parties cannot access them.
 - No replacements for lost or forgotten lift passes.
 - Refunds can only be obtained following a sporting accident upon presentation of a medical certificate from a doctor of the area or a local hospital and when the ski pass is handed in at one of the main ticket offices immediately.
 - Swatch Access watches and key gloves can no longer be used as lift passes.
 - There is no refund for day and half-day tickets or in the case of bad weather, stopping of individual services, closing of ski runs or ski areas, danger of avalanches, premature departure or interruptions in operation.
 - Please observe the FIS safety rules.
 - A charge is payable for rescue following accidents on the ski slopes (displayed at the ticket offices).
 - Separate rates for tobogganing in the evening and night skiing.
 - Please observe the General Terms and Conditions governing prices and transport conditions at the individual lifts (displayed at the ticket offices and lifts).
 - Information on additional lift passes (e.g. special periods and hourly tickets) available from the ticket offices.
 - Security note: All pistes are closed from 5pm until 8am (please take note of ski area specific opening times of pistes), with the exception of the clearly marked and floodlit after-dark skiing pistes. In order to offer you an unforgettable skiing experience, piste preparation work is carried out and snow-making machines are in operation at this time (warning: ropes across the piste).
 - In the low season and if there is not enough snow cover, some of the lifts and runs may have to be closed.

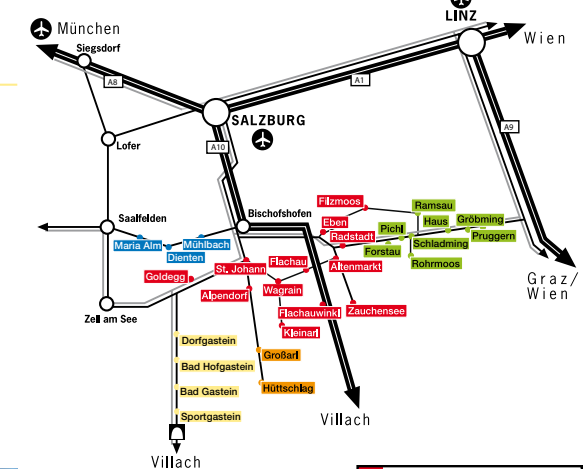
